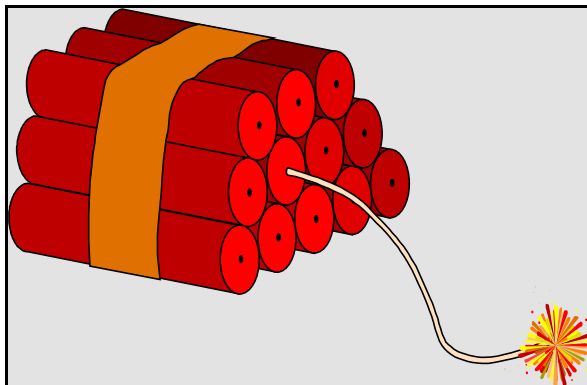




# EXPLOSIVES

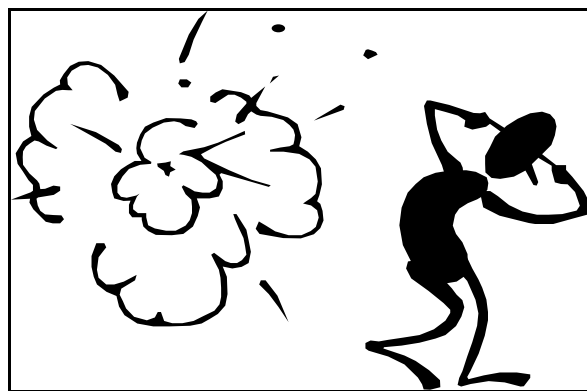
Property Manual



**This department will not store explosives.** This includes all categories of fireworks, bombs, military munitions, gunpowder, blasting caps or other components with incendiary potential.



**Photograph and document**, if explosive is stable and poses no immediate threat. If explosive is unstable or suspicious, treat as a threat and proceed per General Order #36.



Most explosives will be handled by the military **Explosive Ordinance Detection** unit. If an explosive does not warrant immediate disposal by the E.O.D. (ie. small fireworks), arrange for destruction by qualified personnel a.s.a.p.



## Points of Interest

- Refer to General Order #36 *Bomb Threats and Explosive Devices* in the police department's Operational Manual for additional information.
- The nearest E.O.D. or Army Bomb Disposal is located at Fort Indiantown Gap, PA. **Telephone # 717-861-2822.**
- **Post blast residue** should be collected and sealed in a paper bag or paint can. If submitting to the Lab, reinforce container seal with packaging tape and store in the *freezer* prior to examination.
- *Ignitable Liquids* may be packaged as described under CHEMICALS in this manual.
